



Sealegs2 Sailing Trips Milford Haven – Information and Consent From

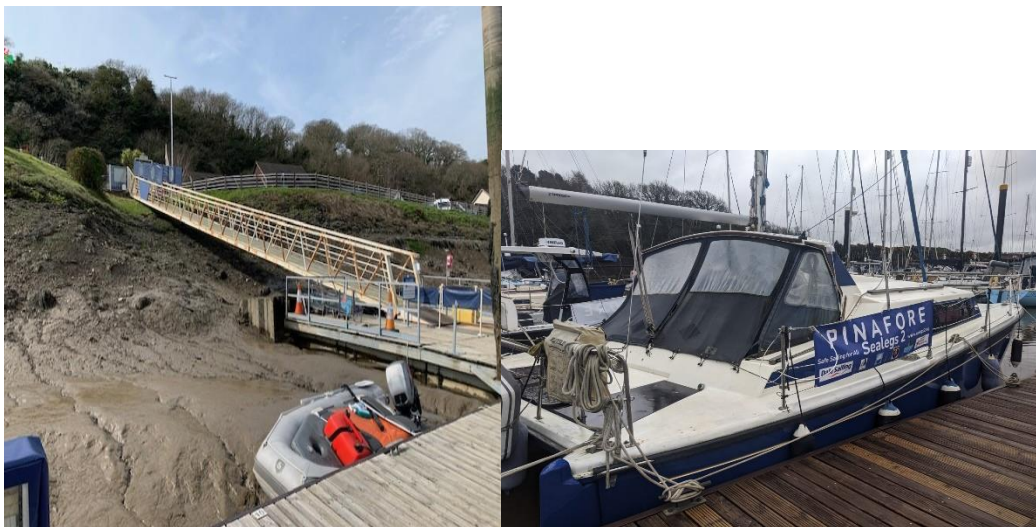
What to Expect

This leaflet is written to help you decide if sailing is suitable for you or someone you provide care for. The two boats, Pinafore and Verity K will be illustrated through photographs showing the access onto the boats.

Where : Access Neyland Marina

Trips on the Sealegs 2 Catamaran , Pinafore, are typically from Berth F11 at Neyland Marina , down opposite the Manilla’s Coffee Shop. Parking is next to the marina office with some disabled parking places. Toilets (including a disabled toilet) are next to the Coffee shop. Please note that toilet facilities on the boats are limited and take into account the possible length of the trip.

Access onto the pontoon (via a code we will send you) will be via a ramp which can vary in height (due to the tide). In the event of very low tides, the skippers may decide it is not safe for you to get down onto the pontoon, but you will be notified in advance. If you bring a wheelchair, **then contact us before you attempt access to the ramp** since having a second person maybe required to ensure safe descent.



Access onto The Boats :

Pinafore

Pinafore is a Catamaran which is stable in the water and provides wide access at the back of the boat and the boat can be pulled closer to the side of the pontoon for ease of access. The deck is flat but does require a step down into the cockpit.



Verity K.

Verity was purpose built for disabled people. Verity K has a built-in ramp to get onto the boat with simple access for wheelchairs and a powered lift to get down into the cockpit..



But Verity K is monohull which can provide more variation in the boat’s tilt and may suit those who are more adventurous.
